

This Agreement is for purchase of a Goldendoodle puppy from Colleen Bowman of McKenzie Crest GoldenDoodles of Eugene, Oregon, herein referred to as "seller" and _____ herein referred to as "Buyer" The puppy is sold on a pet contract, and is to be neutered or spayed by the age of six (6) months unless other arrangements have been made.

Non-Refundable Deposit

Non-refundable (except for reasons below) security deposit to reserve a puppy for purchase is \$300. Buyer will specify which type and size puppy, and estimated litter date desired; and state male/female and color/coat preferences. If the male/female choice cannot be met in the planned litter, then buyer agrees to move their reservation forward to the next expected litter. Buyer agrees to be flexible and accept coat color available and acknowledges that seller cannot guarantee size of puppy when grown. The \$300.00 deposit will reserve your puppy until two weeks after the puppy is born and at that time, the balance is due in full from buyer. Puppies will go to new homes no sooner than eight weeks of age. Waiting lists will be kept in a first-come, first-serve order for the expected litters. Purchaser's name will be put on waiting list upon receipt of deposit. If there are not enough puppies in the litter, or if an expected litter does not arrive as anticipated, then the buyer's name will be placed on the list for the next available litter. Sellers will provide Buyers with a puppy within one year of receipt of Buyer's deposit, and if this fails to occur, the security deposit will be refunded. Purchasers agree that they are buying a puppy "sight unseen". Purchasers agree to be flexible and work with sellers in matching people with puppies, so that families will all receive a puppy that is right for them. The estimated weights cannot be guaranteed and buyer acknowledges he/she is aware of the possibility that their puppy may not fall within these weight ranges when grown.

Because this is a crossbreed, and is not a "standardized breed" there are no guarantees for size, weight or coat types when grown. Sellers will endeavor to make the best match possible between puppies and people, using the preferences stated in this Agreement and Puppy Application, before the puppies go to new homes at 8 weeks of age or older.

Goldendoodle Puppy purchase includes the following:

- Copies of AKC (or other recognized registry) registration papers for both registered parent dogs (if first goldendoodle);
- One Year Health Guarantee (see following pages); and
- Health Record with list of vaccinations, dewormings and other treatments;
- Blanket and toy (some airlines will no longer allow items in kennel).

Procedure to Secure Puppy

Initial Health - Three Day Guarantee

Three (3) days from arrival of the puppy, he/she is guaranteed against poor health with proof of examination and diagnosis by a veterinarian. The puppy may be returned at the buyer's expense for refund or replacement with all papers and a letter from the veterinarian describing the health problems. "Poor health" does not include minor problems such as ear mites, fleas, ticks, worms or coccidia unless severe and life threatening.

The puppy will have been vaccinated for parvo virus and this should give protection until the second vaccination which should be scheduled at around twelve (12) weeks of age. We recommend that the puppy stay out of public areas where he/she could contract parvo virus from infected dog feces until one week after the second vaccination. It is the buyer's responsibility not to expose the puppy to contagious situations.

Extended One Year Guarantee

We guarantee against all serious or life threatening genetic disease up to the age of twelve months. The seller reserves the right to have a second opinion from a veterinarian of our choice at the buyer's expense.

In the case of hip dysplasia, the buyer must submit both the x-ray and the accompanying report from OFA, OVC or PennHip. In the event that the hip dysplasia affects the dog's quality of life, hampers the dog's natural movement and requires surgery to correct the problem, the dog may be returned at the buyer's expense for refund, replacement, or, at the seller's discretion, the buyer may keep the affected dog and have the purchase price refund put directly towards veterinary costs. The onset and severity of hip dysplasia is affected by many environmental factors. Care must be taken to make sure puppies are not over exercised, nor frequently forced to walk on slippery surfaces or climb stairs.

The puppy should be fed good quality dog food and not have been overweight at any time during the guarantee period. Obesity renders the hip dysplasia guarantee null and void. See the health and nutrition pages for more information.

In the event of an eye defect, submit a copy of the CERF report from an examination by a qualified ophthalmologist.

Purchaser agrees to spay or neuter the puppy at the age recommended by their vet, procedure is required prior to puppy reaching one year of age. Purchaser agrees that this puppy is sold strictly as a pet and will not be used for breeding. Buyer agrees to send proof of spay or neutering to the sellers. Failure to spay or neuter the puppy and provide verifying documentation, will constitute a breach of contract for "pet" purchase and will obligate purchaser to compensate seller for "breeder" purchase, calculated at least twice the amount of "pet" price.

The buyer agrees to maintain this puppy in good health, providing routine preventative health care including but not limited to regular visits to a veterinarian for vaccinations, parasite control and physical examinations. Failure to comply with this section nullifies the guarantee.

The following conditions are not covered by this guarantee because of environmental factors: cancer, allergies, thyroid dysfunction, demodectic mange and other autoimmune disorders.

Any health problems which are or could be the result of injury, trauma, abuse, neglect or failure to maintain the general health of this dog are not covered by this health guarantee. Veterinary records must be sent to seller if any claims on this health guarantee are made.

The health guarantee is non-transferable; all guarantees stated apply to the original buyer only.

Upon execution of the contract all veterinary care and its associated costs are the sole and exclusive responsibility of the Buyer.

Buyer agrees to return the dog to Seller, or allow Seller to re-home dog should buyer fail to be able to keep dog. Buyer agrees to never relinquish the dog to an animal shelter, rescue organization or puppy mill.

Under no circumstances shall the seller be liable to the Buyer or to any third party for any consequential incidental or special damages resulting from or in manner related to the dog.

Airline Shipping

The cost of transporting a puppy to its new home will include the cost of airfare, cost to transport puppy to the airport, veterinary exam and airline health certificate, and purchase of an airline-approved shipping crate. Total costs for shipping will be a flat fee of \$400 (shipping charges may change due to increasing costs from airlines). If we are meeting you at the airport to deliver your puppy, the cost for that delivery is \$150 and will include the airline health certificate prepared at veterinarian's 8-week exam, but buyer must provide shipping container for onboard transport of the puppy. Airlines that provide a quality pet shipping service include Delta, Continental, and American Airlines. Shipping requirements set forth by the airlines as well as USDA will be strictly adhered to, including: Health certificates from licensed veterinarian for puppy being shipped; age of dog when shipping: minimum 8 weeks old, weaned for 5 or more days; food and water for pups less than 16 weeks old when air transit time is longer than 12 hours; and cages and shipping containers correct size, airflow, adequate strength for safety travel.

Sellers and Purchasers agree to abide by the terms of this Agreement. Health guarantee is made part of the signed document.

The parties agree that this document represents the entire Agreement between them and that no other representations have been made regarding the dog described herein.
